

District Apostle Helper Mhango visits NACRO's Kazigande ECCDC in Blantyre

District Apostle Helper Arnold Mhango on Easter Monday, 5th April 2021 visited a newly constructed Kazigande Early Childhood Care and Development Centre (ECCDC), a NACRO project at Kazigande Village, Group Village Headman Kesinala, in Senior Chief Kuntaja area in Blantyre. This area is near Chikuli Trading Centre in Blantyre rural district about 40 km north of Blantyre City.

In his presentation, Frank Malunga who represented NACRO (**New Apostolic Church Relief Organization**) during the visit said that construction of the infrastructure has been completed but COVID 19 pandemic has delayed some activities of the Centre like enrollment of pupils and formation of savings self – help groups for parents and guardians. However, Malunga was sure that pupils will be enrolled at the school in the next term.

A total budget of over K100M was used to construct the Centre which has a capacity to enroll 150 pupils. The school infrastructure includes administration area, three-classroom block, feeding area, kitchen, toilets and a borehole. NAK Karitativ funded the project.

Speaking on behalf of the community, Village headman Kazigande and the Project Chair, Mika Tdiale thanked NACRO for the project.

Concluding the visit, District Apostle Helper thanked all who took part in the establishment of the Centre and appealed to the community to take good care of the facility by avoiding vandalizing it.

Apostle Charles Godwin Zimba and Bishop Joseph Lasson Ntiza accompanied the District Apostle Helper among others.
