

Farmers Business Simulation Game Now Playing in Zimbabwe

In 2019, NACRO and Savings Bank of Germany signed a Memorandum of Understanding for capacitation of farmers through the Farmers Business Simulation Game. According to the agreement terms, the cooperation would be extended to Zimbabwean farmers. This was however delayed by the global pandemic which brought the entire world to a standstill.

The Farmers Business Simulation Game finally crossed the borders of Zambia into Zimbabwe on the 15th of March 2021. 19 Farmers from the New Apostolic Church and other Organisations converged in Harare for the inaugural FBS training which ran for 4 days. The training was received with much vigor and excitement as evidenced by the countrywide calls for more training by farmers.

It is against this backdrop that the NACRO Executive Director has made efforts for the FBS Game to spread its wings across the Provinces of Zimbabwe. The two parties are finalizing a longer -term MOU that will benefit more Zimbabwean farmers.

The Facilitation was spearheaded by Mr Kaumba Mwananyambe from Zambia together with Precious Sibiyá and Vincent Chikomo.
